Text: Acts 2:42/John 13:5-9

Objective: The focus of the series this month is “We the People”. We are going to be learning who God has called us to be as family of believers. He has called us to be a community who will come together to change our city.

Illustration: Tell a story of sometime when you went somewhere and excluded a friend from coming with you.

Intro: We are looking at the second part of our “We the People” series this week. In Acts 2:42 we see that they fellowshiped and shared in meals. The word fellowship here refers to a close intimate relationship; the relationships that close friends have. Close relationships are relationships that have a lot of trust and respect. For us to go “further” in our relationship with the Lord we have to be willing to get close to Him to allow Him to be in all areas of our life.

Ask the following questions:

Do you have a best friend? What makes them your best friend?

What are some areas in your life that you can change to allow yourself to get closer to God?

What was Jesus trying to teach His disciples by washing their feet in John 13?

Conclusion: In John 13 we see Jesus washing His disciple's feet. He did this to show the closeness of His love for them. How close is Jesus in your life? Give an opportunity for salvation and invite them to the 220 Service on Thursday night.
